

- » Nonstick vegetable cooking spray
- » 1 1/2 lbs red snapper fillets
- » 1 tsp salt-free herb seasoning blend
- » 1 tbsp olive oil
- » 4 minced garlic cloves
- » 4 chopped green onions
- » 1 tbsp grated fresh ginger root
- » 2 tbsp lemon juice
- » 1/3 cup apple juice
- » 2 tbsp honey
- » 1 cup long-grain brown rice, cooked according to directions without salt or fat

Preheat oven to 375°F. In a large baking dish that has been sprayed with nonstick vegetable cooking spray, arrange snapper fillets across the bottom of the dish. Sprinkle with salt-free herb seasoning blend. In a skillet, over medium-high heat, add olive oil, garlic, and onions. Saute for 2 minutes. Add ginger root, lemon juice, apple juice, and honey. Cook for 1 minute and remove from heat. Pour over snapper fillets and cover baking dish with foil. Bake for 20 to 25 minutes or until fish flakes easily with a fork. Serve with hot cooked brown rice. Serves 4.

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
